March 13, 2019

Old Business:

Status of a Relocation Plan:

Joan advised that the Ad Hoc Relocation Committee (consisting of Joan Cretella, Brian Slugoski, Chief Gagne, Paul Dinice, Zoning Enforcement Officer, as well as Building Inspector Lucien DiMeo and Fire Marshal Tim Smith) has been meeting and Jenna, attorney with Cohen & Wolf, who has drawn up a draft document with input from committee members. A final document will be presented to the First Selectman and the Board of Selectmen for approval.

Building Security – High Plains Community Center

Joan asked that the doors near the flag pole at the War Memorial in the front of the building and the side of the building near Community Services/Nursery School be exit doors only. Discussion was held. As there are so many doors, it is difficult to control the foot traffic into the building. Chief Gagne advised that there is a plan under Capital Improvements to add cameras at High Plains Community Center.

High Plains Renovation update.

Both John Stewart and Dan Lynch advised that the renovation in the South wing is progressing nicely with the project to be complete sometime in May. The locker room renovation is in process, projected completion is July 1.
