### **1. CALL TO ORDER**

### B. Personnel – Dan Lynch

- Mr. Lynch reported that two new seasonal maintenance staff members will begin working on Monday, April first.

### C. Budget

- There were no questions regarding the current budget. Mr. Lynch indicated that he could transfer money from one line item to another line item if so needed.

### D. Director's Report

- Mr. Lynch spoke about the pool locker room renovations. The pool is currently shut down and the lifeguards are not working at this time. Pool members can use the alternate pool locations at the Jewish Community Center and the Woodbridge Town Pool. The expected completion for this project is July first.
- Mr. Lynch also gave an update on the South Wing renovations at High Plains Community Center. The expected completion time is the end of May or the beginning of June. The Exercise Room continues to remain open to members.
- Mr. Lynch mentioned that there is a new page on their website titled "What's New." This page will continue to give pool renovation updates as well as list the upcoming programs. Summer Camp will begin on June seventeenth and registration begins on April 29<sup>th</sup>. Traveling Teens registration begins on April 22<sup>nd</sup>.
- Mr. Lynch concluded by noting that a Programs Report and an Aquatics Report was included in the Commissioners' packets.
