Brian Slugoski reported that September was a busy month for restaurant inspections. There were some low scores mentioned and a closing of one restaurant in particular. Discussion continued on the restaurants with the failing scores and how to fix the ongoing problems.



Judy Benson distributed the disease monitoring report for the FY 18/19. Discussion continued.

Carol Luddy made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Dr. Marieb seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 8:21 p.m.
