The meeting was called to order by Dennis Marsh, at 10:07 a.m. in the Conference Room of the Case Memorial Library.

Present were Dennis Marsh, Kathy Giotsas, Terry Waldron RN, John Stewart, Brian Slugoski, Ann Denny, and Ryan Wells of H.G. Segur.

The minutes of the March 17, 2021, meeting were approved on a motion made by Terry Waldron, seconded by John Stewart, and unanimously approved.

Old Business:

a. Status of Covid Protocols in Town Buildings:

John Stewart reported signs are posted in town buildings that visitors are still asked at this time to continue to wear masks. Employees that have been vaccinated do not need to wear their masks but may continue to do so if they wish. Dennis Marsh brought up the issue of residents who come to the community center that do not want to wear them anymore. Brian said if they are vaccinated it should not be an issue. The town is doing well there have been no cases in the last three weeks.

b. Covid 19 Vaccines:

Terry reported clinics have ended and she is still doing homebound visits. Close to 70% of adult residents have been vaccinated in Orange. Yale West Campus still operating for vaccines but getting ready to shut down.

c. Re-opening plans for Town buildings as State restrictions lift:

As stated, masks are still required for visitors at this time. Schools will be evaluated for masks closer to the start of school.

New Business:

a. Any other new business: Dennis Marsh asked if there were any other concerns people wanted to address about town buildings. Dennis mentioned following up on locking doors at the community center. He feels the senior lounge door should not be an entrance from the parking lot it is a safety concern in the winter when there is snow. John will look at getting a sign posted. Brian Slugoski asked if the tree warden could look at the tree near the front driveway at town hall. Ann will send Don Foyer a message about it. Ryan Wells introduced himself and spoke of the services he is available to help the Town with.

On the motion made by Dennis Marsh, seconded by John Stewart and unanimously carried, the meeting adjourned at 10:36 a.m. The next meeting is September 15th at the Library.
